



Ardenne High School Sixth Form Admission Requirements 2023 – 2024

Admission to Sixth Form will be based on both academic and non-academic criteria. Students will be assessed on the following areas:

NON - ACADEMIC CRITERIA

- Leadership qualities
- Attendance to school and classes
- Punctuality to school and classes
- Involvement in extra-curricular activities
- Fulfilling community service obligations
- Conduct/deportment (the number of truancies, demerits, order marks, deportment marks and suspensions) will be taken into consideration
- Compliance with the guidelines set by teachers with regards to the SBAs

ACADEMIC CRITERIA

To be considered for admission to Grade 12, applicants must:

- Pass at least **6 subjects** at the CSEC General Proficiency Level or GCE Ordinary Level Examinations or a combination of the two at the CSEC Level.
- At the CSEC Level, students must obtain at least 4 subjects with Grade 1 and at the GCE, O'Level, students must obtain at least 4 A's.
- Students **MUST** achieve a Grade 1 or 2 in the subject that they wish to pursue in Grade 12.
- Students must also earn a Grade 1 or 2 in **English Language and Mathematics**.

To be considered for admission to Grade 13, all applicants must:

- Pass a minimum of two subjects in the CXC CAPE external examinations of the Grade 12 sitting
- Not be suspended during the previous academic year

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORMS

1. The confirmation page along with an application fee of \$4000.00 (non-refundable) is to be submitted to the **Necessities** at Ardenne High School. The final date for submission of application forms is **Friday August 11, 2023**. Please note that no application form will be accepted / processed without the application fee being paid.
2. Students' files will be reviewed for the non-academic aspect of the entry requirement.
3. Academic assessment will be done once the CSEC results are published.
4. **An acceptance list** of those students who have fulfilled all the matriculation requirements and whose applications have been approved will be posted in a Google drive and the link will be shared with the successful applicants.
5. **Those students to be interviewed** will be contacted and given an appointment. Students are interviewed for a number of reasons. These include assistance with subject selection and career guidance.

- Management of Business - Principles of Business
- Physics - Physics
- Pure Mathematics- Additional Mathematics and Mathematics
- Sociology - Caribbean History OR Caribbean History and Social Studies
- Spanish - Spanish

FEES

The fees for Grades 12 & 13 for 2023- 2024 are as follows:

- Sixth Form Fee - \$62,000
- PTA Dues - \$5,000
- Library and Information Technology Fee - \$2,300
- Technology Development Fees - \$6,900 (**Applicable to Computer Science Students**)
- Digital Media Lab Fees - \$6,900 (**Applicable to Digital Media Students**)
- Animation and Gaming Design - \$6900.00 (**Applicable to Animation and Gaming Design**)
- Digital Media and Animation and Gaming Design - \$10350.00 (**Applicable only if registering for both subjects**)
- Science Lab Fees \$3,450 (**Flat rate for first Science Subject**) AND \$1,380 per additional science subject thereafter (**Applicable to Science students only including Agricultural Science and Environmental Science**)

These fees **MUST** be paid before the student is allowed to attend classes.

NOTE: THE AMOUNT PAID BY THE GOVERNMENT IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE ABOVE.
